



Volunteer Standards of Conduct

Liberty Tree Academy (LTA) volunteers are in a unique position to influence the character and atmosphere of the school, both within its walls and out in the community. Therefore, volunteers are held to the same standard as employees. This includes refraining from sharing information obtained during volunteer hours and from posting/commenting on social media in a way that may reflect poorly on the school. This could be perceived as someone on the inside being privy to confidential information.

Additionally, volunteers must refrain from unprofessional language on school property. They must model their dress after LTA staff; no denim, leggings, sneakers, or t-shirts. Use of cell phones and photography while on school grounds are not permitted.

We appreciate our volunteers very much and are thankful that they are willing to adhere to the professional standards that our staff strives to uphold. Our families are welcome to meet with our administration privately about concerns that they may have regarding the school. By signing this form, you indicate that you are willing to uphold the standards of conduct as described herein.
