



The Lion, the Witch and the Wardrobe - 2021 Commitment Information

Thank you for auditioning for [LWW](#)! If you are cast, below is some information on what to expect from your commitment.

Rehearsal Schedule

Beginning [October](#), rehearsals will be held [Monday and Wednesday afternoons](#) from 3:35pm-5:30pm. Rehearsals may be extended (with notice) if more time is needed. Some Saturday mornings from 9am-12noon have been added. Rehearsals will be called by scene/character, so not every actor will be called to every rehearsal until a couple of weeks prior to the show. All rehearsals will be held at Liberty Tree Academy
Important dates: Mandatory First Rehearsal/Parent Meeting on [Monday, October 12](#) at 7:30pm over zoom. [Mandatory Dress Rehearsals](#) are [April 27, 28](#) and [March 1, 2, 3](#). [Performances](#) are [March 4-7](#), and [strike](#) will be [March 7](#) following the show & [March 8](#) from 6pm-8:30pm.

Cast Fee

There will be a \$75 fee to each cast member, which will cover the cost of the actors' scripts, show DVD, cast tshirt and contribute to the general production costs. This fee is due within two weeks of casting and is not refundable if the actor leaves the show.

Things that can and could cost money

Videography: If you desire more than one copy of the show DVD, they will be available for an additional TBD fee.

Costume & Make-Up: Due to Covid, cast members needing stage makeup for their character will be expected to provide their own makeup for the show. For those who do not own stage makeup, Ben Nye Theatrical Make-Up kits cost about \$20 - Actors should not share make-up kits.

Small toiletry items will not be provided by Costumes. Cast members may be asked to provide personal items of clothing like socks, stockings, camisoles, white dress shirts, men's dress shoes, women's dance shoes, black pants etc.

Volunteer Expectations

It takes a great team to put on a show! ALL cast and their families will be expected to participate by volunteering various areas. Volunteer areas can include set construction,

working at the box office or concessions table, child wrangling during rehearsals and performances and donating dress rehearsal meals. We ask for a minimum of 10 hours of volunteer help from each family (not including STRIKE). Cast members will be given a sheet or online signup with volunteer opportunities at first rehearsal on [October 7](#).

Conflicts

All conflicts for the fall must be presented to the directing team by callbacks on Thursday, September 22. Actors are only allowed 2 additional approved conflicts (non-emergency) after casting. Extra conflicts after casting may result in your removal from the show.

Adults (18+) and Parents

Cast members, parents and volunteers associated with the show will be required to pass LTA background checks.

Callbacks

Callbacks - if not given at the audition - will be posted online **Monday, October 5th by 12 midnight**. Please check the website/facebook to see if you have received a callback, and plan to attend callback auditions on [Wednesday, October 7](#). If you do not receive a callback, it does NOT mean you have NOT been cast. Additionally, receiving a callback does NOT guarantee you a role in the show.

Cast List - Audition Results!

The Cast List will be posted on our website on Friday, October 9th between 2pm-5pm. Actors are expected to indicate their role preferences during auditions, so that they are able to accept whichever role is offered them by the production team.
