Acadience Reading (K-3: S, L) (4-6: L)	Aug. 12 - Aug. 26 Dec. 4 - Dec. 18 Apr. 26 - May 10	Benchmark and progress monitoring assessment measuring the acquisition of basic early literacy skills	About 10 minutes per benchmark period plus time for ongoing progress monitoring (may vary).
Acadience Math (K-5: L)	Aug. 12 - Sept. 18 Dec. 1 - Dec. 15 Apr. 26 - May 7	Benchmark and progress monitoring assessment measuring the acquisition of basic math skills	About 10 minutes per benchmark period plus time for ongoing progress monitoring (may vary).
CogAT	Sept. 1 - Oct. 2	Cognitive abilities test for third- and sixth-graders. Intended to help teachers, counselors and specialists recognize and support gifted behaviors and characteristics.	90 Minutes
ACCESS for ELLs (S), (F)	Jan. 11 - Feb. 11	Assesses kindergarten through 12th-graders on progress in acquiring academic English. Test is only for English language learners.	About 2 hours, 30 minutes
CMAS: ELA, Math (S)	Mar. 29 - Apr. 30 (online) Apr. 12 - Apr. 30 (paper)	Assesses third through eighth-graders on mastery of Colorado Academic Standards in English language arts and math.	ELA (English Language Arts) approximately (3) 90-minute units for third through fifth-graders. (3) 110-minute units for sixth through eighth-graders. Math – (3) 65 minute units.
CMAS: Science (S)	Apr. 12 - Apr. 30	Assesses fifth, eighth, and 11th-graders on mastery of grade level Colorado Academic Standards in science.	About 3 hours
PSAT 9 (S)	Apr. 13, 14, or 15 (Initial) contact school for specific dates and times.	9th-grader English-language arts and math assessment measuring career and college readiness aligned to Colorado State Standards.	About 3 hours
PSAT 10 (S)	Apr. 13, 14, or 15 (Initial) contact school for specific dates and times.	10th-grader English-language arts and math assessment measuring career and college readiness aligned to Colorado State Standards.	About 3 hours
