

Graduation Requirements for Liberty Tree Academy

At Liberty Tree Academy (LTA) we require the following credits to graduate.

English 1 credit (has to be English Comp)

Literature 4 credits (Ancient Literature, English Literature, American Literature, and Modern Literature are LTA classes, however some other English/Literature classes may transfer in if a student is a transfer student that came to LTA later in high school, however those other classes have to be reviewed to ensure matching of LTA classes for similar content)

Mathematics 4 credits (2 students' choice and 2 required)

2 students' choice

2 **Required classes:** Geometry and Algebra 2

History 5.5 credits (3 student's choice and 2.5 required)

LTA offers Western Civilization I/II, American History (Great War – 1918+) (However, some other History classes may transfer in if a student is a transfer student that came to LTA later in high school, however those other classes have to be reviewed to ensure matching of LTA classes for similar content)

Required classes: Modern American History (1 credit), Moral Philosophy (.5 credit), Government (.5 credit) and Economics (.5 credits)

Science 4 credits

Foreign Language 3 credits

2 years of the same language (2 credits) ie.. 2 full years of Spanish

1 year must be Latin, however this may be waived for a transfer student entering LTA later in high school but, the additional credit must be made up in another content area.

P.E. 1 credit (.5 PE and .5 Nutrition or Health)

Senior Seminar .5 credit

Electives 4 credits

2 credits student's choice

2 Fine Arts (1 must be Rhetoric)

For total of 27 required credits to graduate at LTA.
